Proposal Guidelines

Each Special Session proposal must include the following details:

- 1. Title of the Special Session
- 2. Description (max 300 words) of the session topic, significance, and objectives
- 3. Organizer(s) Information: Full Name(s), Affiliation(s), Email(s)
- 4. List of Potential Contributors (if available)
- 5. Short Biography (approx. 150 words) for each organizer

• Proposal submission deadline: November 20, 2025

• Notification of acceptance: December 5, 2025

• Conference dates: April 25–27, 2026

Responsibilities of Special Session Organizers

- Promote the session and attract quality submissions.
- Coordinate the review process in collaboration with the Technical Program Committee.
- Ensure accepted papers meet IEEE formatting and quality standards.
- Chair the session during the conference.
